

#### Community oral health program - each child receives:

An e-Chart Oral prophylaxis Nonsurgical disease intervention Oral health education Personal toothbrush Access to fluoride toothpaste for daily brushing

#### **Parameters**

10 month timeframe 16 dental hygiene students 10 dental student research assistants trained in e-Charting

### Community oral health program successfully launched as Teeth for Health Save a Tooth, a Life, a Nation

#### 7 Barangays 1,588 individuals












#### **INITIAL BUDGET**

- 3k USD grant
- 1,140 USD personal
- 8,422 USD value in-kind donations

### CONSUMABLES

• 3.86 USD per person







# As of Today...



- Reported by FDI in 2014, Philippines **#1** in caries incidence in Asia
- Still no up-to-date Philippines public oral health data
- 2011 most recent data from DOH
- 2018 proposed funding for Philippine oral health programs to add more government dentists but no dental hygienists or a database
- Only a little over **300** registered dental hygienists in the nation
- In the 7000+ islands there are 36 dental colleges with only 1 offering a dental hygiene program



### Outcomes







- Increase oral health awareness

- Establish a standard of care model for dental missions
  - ✓ data acquisition
  - ✓ oral-systemic education

- Improve overall health for better quality of life
- Establish community health for the dental hygienist to be standard curriculum
